#### When and where is it held?

College Goal Sunday in Georgia will be held Sunday, February 10, 2008 at 2:00 pm at several locations throughout the state of Georgia. Locations are on the website.

#### What can I get?

Bring your latest tax information or your last paycheck stub that you received at the end of December. If you are under 24, also bring your parent/s or guardian.

#### What if I haven't done my taxes yet?

That's okay. Bring the tax information that you have. There will be chances to make changes if needed when your taxes are completed.

#### Do I have to know where I'm going to school?

No. But, have some idea of your college choices and bring them.

#### What can I do now?

Go to www.pin.ed.gov and apply for a PIN number. This number allows both the student and parent/s to apply for aid online, make corrections on information given on the FAFSA and access your records. Both student and parent/s need a PIN number and need it BEFORE the FAFSA is submitted.
